



Dear La Roca FC Family,

In case you missed last week's announcement about La Roca FC's partnership with Fundeazy, we've included the press release below. We want to assure you that we share your concerns about the uncertain future, and La Roca has a plan for reducing the financial burden of soccer. We will be officially launching the program in a few weeks, so watch for more details.

As we head into the second week of La Roca FC tryouts, we remind you that we are committed to keeping everyone safe and healthy by following the COVID guidelines developed by Utah Youth Soccer Association and the Utah Department of Health. The most important thing you can do is keep your child home if he or she is not feeling well; your child's coach will understand and support your decision to keep your child home. Ask your child how he/she is feeling before bringing them to tryouts.

A chart of the La Roca Tryouts COVID Guidelines is included in this newsletter. Please review it with your child prior to tryouts. The current COVID guidelines require that all players and parents practice social distancing by remaining 6' apart and wearing a face mask when not engaged in on-field activities. Please ensure your child is wearing a face mask when they arrive at tryouts and has their own hand sanitizer in their soccer bag to use before, during, and after tryouts.

The UYSA guidelines also prohibit spectators at soccer events, including tryouts. *All parents must remain in or next to their cars during La Roca FC tryouts.*

Remember to register your child for tryouts *before midnight the night before the first tryout session* so that your child appears on the tryout roster. ALL players should attend both days of tryouts, even returning La Roca players. Tryout results will be posted by tryout number on larocafc.com by the end of the day Sunday, June 21, for U13-19 players.
