The La Roca Difference

Fee Breakdown:

UYSA Fees: (required for all clubs) League and Membership Fees are paid to Utah Youth Soccer Association and include the cost of player insurance and league administration.

Ref Fee: Covers the cost of paying league game referees.

Admin Fee:

The administrative fee is essential for ensuring the smooth operation and sustainability of our club. Our La Roca area administrators play a crucial role in managing the day-to-day operations of the teams in their area and ensuring that they are functioning both on and off the field according to club standards. Admins serve as a point of contact for club members, parents, coaches, and DOC's and oversee all events in their area.

Indoor Training Facility Fee: La Roca uses top-notch indoor training facilities such as La Roca Park, Zions Bank Real Academy and the La Roca Pleasant Grove Training Center. This cost is applied to every La Roca North, Salt Lake and South player.

La Roca secures the Regional Athletic Center (RAC), the Utah County Complex, and various county and school fields for all league games. La Roca provides access to secured outdoor fields for all areas which include: La Roca Park, Utah County Complex and various schools and parks throughout the year.

La Roca FC is fully operational in 5 areas of Utah (Davis/Weber, SLC, Utah County, Spanish Fork and St George).

This club fee includes compensation for Directors of Coaching, registrars, referee assignors, and goalkeeper trainers. Through this fee we offer continued coaching education and team equipment. The club fee also includes misc items such as: insurance, Worker's Compensation, payroll processing fees, bank fees, credit card service fees, events, tryouts, marketing, office supplies and other related expenses.

Training Fee:

La Roca has the most A, B & C licensed coaches in the state with access to our customized curriculum and methodology. This fee is the compensation for your coach with related payroll taxes included. The training fees will increase with age and level of play, as coaches spend more time training older teams and/or premier teams.
